This position is full-time, fixed term for a period of up to two years, with an expected start date in term 1, 2018.

Physical Education Mentors support and mentor teachers in primary and intermediate schools, and provide professional learning and development for schools involved in Play.sport. You will be a physically active person with at least 4-5 years of successful classroom teaching experience, and be prepared to model effective teaching practice in the physical education curriculum. You will join our team supporting and mentoring teachers within a cluster of Upper Hutt schools to develop their confidence and competence to plan, teach and assess quality physical education experiences for their students.

#### Requirements for this position

- Proven commitment to improving outcomes for all students, and in particular for Māori students, Pasifika students, students with special education needs and students from low socio-economic backgrounds.
- Passion for the teaching and learning of Physical Education in primary and/or intermediate schools.
- Minimum of a Bachelor's degree and preferably evidence of ongoing study or professional learning.
- Current full New Zealand teacher registration.
- Full New Zealand driver's license, as some travel will be part of this work.
- Please note that the successful applicant will be required to undertake police vetting.
