We are seeking a highly motivated and knowledgeable Subject Advisor years 9-13 to join our team at Physical Education New Zealand Te Ao Kori Aotearoa. The successful candidate will be responsible for providing subject-specific advice and guidance to Physical Education kaiako and other stakeholders on all aspects of Physical Education, including curriculum design, assessment, and professional development

About us

Physical Education New Zealand Te Ao Kori Aotearoa is the national, professional organisation for physical education in New Zealand. We are the voice for the physical education community, and a credible network of information and knowledge about quality physical education. We provide resources, advice, and advocacy for the physical education sector.

Key responsibilities:

- Designing and facilitating professional learning opportunities for educators online and kanohi ki te kanohi.
- Develop and deliver high-quality training and development programs for teachers and other stakeholders in Physical Education Te Ao Kori Aotearoa.
- Provide expert advice and guidance on all aspects of Physical Education, including national curriculum refresh, NCEA, and Physical Education programs.
- Supporting and delivering Physical Education New Zealand's strategic plan and stakeholder contracts.
- Building relationships and networks with communities of educators, facilitators, and other Stakeholders.
- Making sense of and communicating key changes in education, for example the NCEA changes and Te Mātaiaho, the refreshed framework for the New Zealand Curriculum.

The role is for 0.8 FTE (4 days per week) fixed-term from June 2023 until 18 December 2024. This could extend to other employment possibilities with PENZ, and we are happy to negotiate a smaller FTE if that better suited the right candidate. This is a wonderful opportunity to play a key role in a small team in a very successful organisation. The successful applicant can be based anywhere, but must be willing and able to travel around the country (including overnight trips) from time to time.

Job Requirements

- Available to start in approx. 18 June 2023 (start time negotiable depending on notice for current employer).
- Is a registered, qualified, and experienced teacher with an excellent understanding of New Zealand physical education teaching knowledge, classroom demands, professional requirements, pedagogy, and assessment.
- Has an in-depth knowledge of the physical education curriculum including mātauranga Māori
- Is self-motivated and comfortable working independently
- Is able to work collaboratively with other subject advisors and educational professionals to ensure the delivery of high-quality and effective Physical Education provision.
- Experience in designing and delivering high-quality training and professional learning development for kaiako and other stakeholders.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to work collaboratively with a range of stakeholders.
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Confidence in using technology and social media.
